- LSGT Information Session and Go Team or OSD: Westside READY educational awareness events for parents and community stakeholders

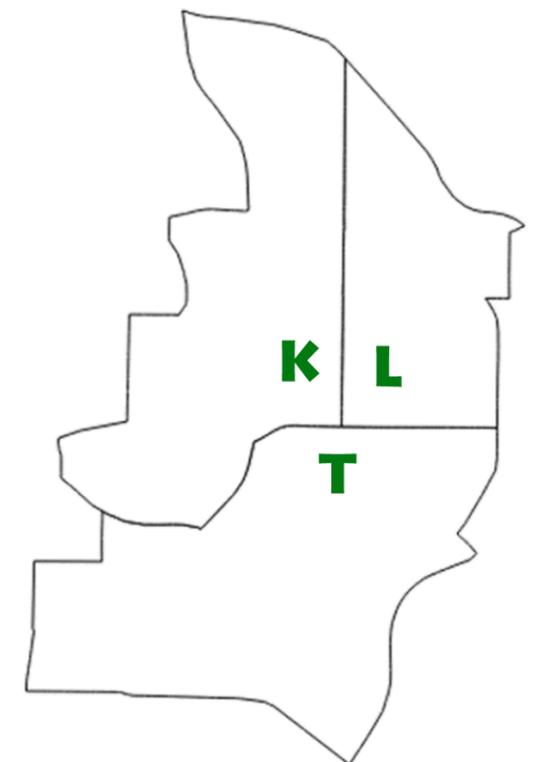
